Step One: Go to www.act.org and set up your **Student Web Account** and/or Log In.

Step Two: Complete the **Personal Profile**.

Step Three: Complete the **Interest Inventory**. Please take advantage of this opportunity to have this valuable information. Results are included on your score report and are very useful in making choices about courses, internships, jobs, careers and majors. MSD will also get a copy and it helps us in advising you on your choices.

Step Four: Complete Your **Test Selection**. It includes the following sections:

- Where to Test
- Registration Information
It will offer a choice "I receive accommodations in school due to a diagnosed and documented disability". Do not choose this if you only need sign language as an accommodation as it is automatic for tests at MSD.
- Test Date Option
